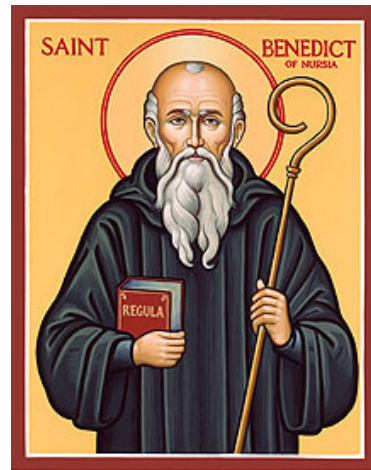


## PRAYER OF ST. BENEDICT OF NURSIA,

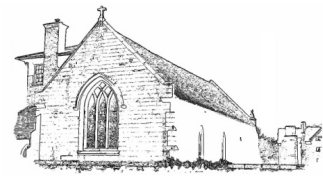
