Each week parishioners kindly donate **via Direct Debit or planned giving envelopes** to St Mary's. This money attracts Gift Aid benefit, a government scheme which returns the tax you had paid on the money you give to St Mary's. Those of you who are already in the scheme will be awaiting their usual, annual certificates of donation from the Archdiocese. We have been advised by their Gift Aid office they are unable to produce these letters this year. If you are unsure of the amount you have donated to St Mary's in the year 2019-2020 please contact the Parish Office and we will be able to provide you with that figure.

THANK YOU everyone for patiently observing the guidelines that allow us to gather inside the church or in the garden at St Mary's.

- As space is limited, please book in to attend Masses **IN CHURCH** on **Sunday at 8.30am and/or Thursdays at 11.00am**, preferably by email (stmarysrc.harvington@gmail.com). Or alternatively by phone (01562 777316) on either Monday or Friday mornings 10.00am -12 noon
- To comply with the '1 metre plus' advice for safe social distancing try to maintain this space but preferably a **two metre distance** from members of other households at all times, especially on arrival and departure.
- **Wear a face mask or similar face covering (these will not be provided, please bring your own)**
- **Use the hand sanitiser provided on entry.**
- When planning any visit to St Mary's in the coming weeks please be aware, **we are unable to allow the use of the lavatory.**
- In order to track and trace, should a case of Covid-19 be found, **all visitors** to either the inside of St Mary's or the garden **will be asked to leave their name and contact details with us**. These will be held securely in accordance with GDPR rules.
- Attendance to Masses **IN THE GARDEN does not need** advance booking.
- Everyone who attends Mass in the garden are asked to please:
 - **not arrive before 10.00am**
 - **provide their own chair**, preferably with a low back to avoid blocking sight lines. Visitors may wish to stand or sit on the ground/ their own rug or mat. For reasons of hygiene, **no parish seating will be provided.**
