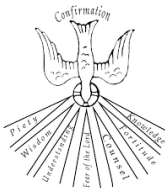


FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Children who will be 8 years old by June of this year are eligible to be prepared to take the sacraments of **Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.**

We are indebted to parishioner Julia Stevens who once again is happy to prepare the children with a series of lessons on three successive Saturday mornings in June. The 12th, 19th and 26th, from 10- 12 in the Priest's House and in the garden, weather permitting! It will be most important for the children to attend all three sessions as we have limited time because of the unusual circumstances this year. The day of First Communion will be the 4th July and sacrament of Reconciliation the day before – 3rd July after a Mass at 10am.

During the 10.30am Mass here at St Mary's today, Sunday 6th June, Stanley will receive Holy Communion for the first time. Please remember him in your prayers.



CONFIRMATION

Children who will be 11 years old by September of this year are eligible to be prepared to receive the sacrament of **Confirmation.**

Parents or guardians of these children are invited to contact the Parish Office by email or telephone registering interest. Under the current restrictions we cannot be sure of how this preparation will take place nor the dates when the sacraments may be taken but we would appreciate knowing how many potential candidates there may be this year.



The obligation for the faithful to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation remains suspended. All the faithful are asked to make an Act of Spiritual Communion:

My Jesus,

I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament.

I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul.

**Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.**

**I embrace You as if You were already there,
and unite myself wholly to You.**
