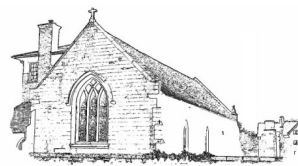

MONDAY 5TH JULY

SAINT ANTHONY ZACCARIA (1502 - JULY 5, 1539)



Born in Cremona, Italy, Saint Anthony Zaccaria organised the group called Clerks Regular of St Paul, and termed Barabited, who worked for the reform of customs and for the renewal of clergy and laity. He was a zealous and untiring preacher who completely wore himself out in his work, He was only thirty-six when he died.

TUESDAY 6TH JULY

ST MARIA GORETTI (1890 - 1902)



She was born near Ancona Italy. The daughter of a poor peasant family, St Maria was well known to her neighbours for her cheerfulness and piety. When she was twelve years of age she became a victim of aggression. She preferred to die rather than to lose her virginity.

FRIDAY 9TH JULY

SS AUGUSTINE ZHAO RONG, PRIEST AND COMPANIONS, MARTYRS



This feast commemorates 120 Chinese martyrs, who suffered between 1648 and 1930. They include European missionaries such as St Gregory Grassi (1823-1900), the Italian born Bishop of North Shanxi martyred during the Boxer rebellion, and indigenous Christians such as St Augustine Zhao Rong, a diocesan priest put to death in 1815. They were canonised by St John Paul II in 2000.
