## FIRST HOLY COMMUNION and CONFIRMATION



Children who will be 8 years old by June this year, who regularly attend Mass at St Mary's and do not go to a Catholic School, are eligible to be prepared by a parish catechist to take

the **sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion**. The children will receive each of the sacraments for the first time on the weekend of 1st & 2nd of June this year.

Children who will be 11 years old by September this year, who regularly attend Mass at St Mary's and do not go to a Catholic School, are eligible to be prepared by a parish catechist to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.

Parents or guardians of these children are invited to complete a relevant form, available from the table in the porch. As the forms will give personal details about children please post these in the labelled, secure, slotted box on the same table.
