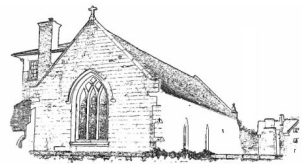

Our annual **SUMMER FETE** will be held in the garden of the Priest's House at St Mary's on **Saturday 5th July**.

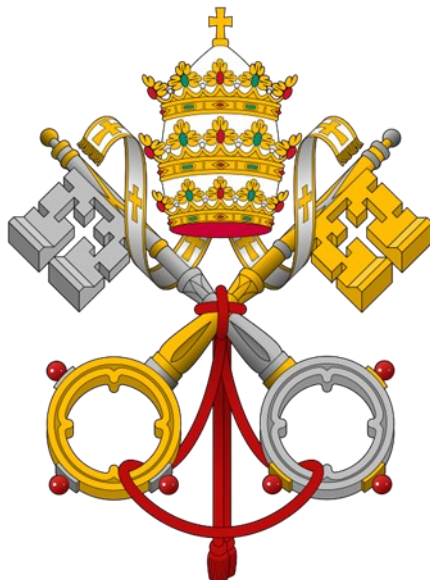
